Built-up areas (Bua)

Castles, Forts for wargamers and collectors.

Being a new player of the DBA rule (De Bellis Antiquitatis), I developed these Bua (Built-up areas) to be compatible with this game in "small scale" version from 15mm to 1/72nd.

However, they are suitable for many other games, considering that each platform of the towers and ramparts are sized to receive a 40mm base (1 BW – Base Width).

1:72 scale "plastic soldiers" can also find their place on these sets.

Here is how the (v₃) DBA rules regarding these Bua were taken into account:

- 1. A Bua must be contained in a 6 BW area (240mm) on two sides of the battlefield (page 7, paragraph 1, sentence 2).
- 2. A Bua would not have to be spaced 1 LB from a table edge like the other elements would be (page 6, paragraph 2, last sentence).



Which gives the following situation:

3. A ZB must not be more than 9 LB by adding its length and its width and its length must not be more than twice its width (page 6).

For this, my plans fall into a red rectangle which takes up the two aforementioned imperatives (2 and 3). The grid of the plans being the LB of 40mm stricto-sensu.

All the fortress configurations presented here are compatible with the conditions of this rule. I give you the plans that will allow you to cut them out and test them on your battlefield.
